ALERT St. Lucie: The St. Lucie County Sheriff's Office utilizes the ALERT St. Lucie Emergency Notification System to deliver emergency and non-emergency pre-recorded phone messages to citizens.

AlertMartin: Emergency notifications will be issued when there are imminent threats to life, health and safety for residents and visitors of Martin County. This can include, but is not limited to, severe weather events, evacuation orders, flooding, boil water notices, gas leaks and more.
